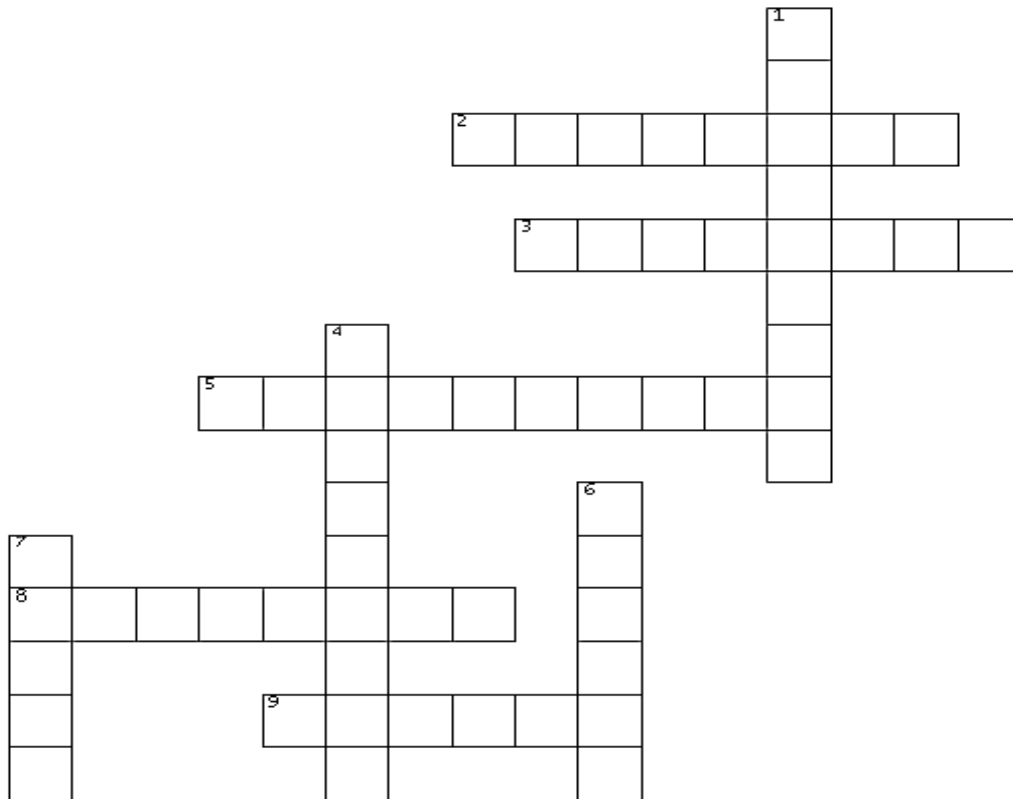

Instruction Manual: How to Set Up a Bluetooth Speaker

Congratulations on your new Bluetooth speaker! Follow these steps to set it up:

- 1. Unpacking:** Inside the box, you will find the speaker, a charging cable, and an instruction manual. Check that all parts are included.
- 2. Charging:** Use the provided charging cable. Connect one end to the speaker and the other to a USB power source. The red light means it's charging. When fully charged, the light turns green.
- 3. Turning On:** Press the power button for 3 seconds. A blue light will flash, meaning the speaker is in pairing mode.
- 4. Connecting:** On your phone, go to Bluetooth settings, and turn on Bluetooth. Select the speaker from the list. The blue light will stop flashing when connected.
- 5. Controlling Music:** You can use the speaker's buttons to play, pause, or skip songs. Volume can be adjusted on either the speaker or your phone.
- 6. Turning Off:** Press the power button for 3 seconds to turn the speaker off. The light will turn off.
- 7. Troubleshooting:** If the speaker doesn't connect, make sure Bluetooth is turned on and the speaker is in pairing mode.
